

WISP requirements: Why expert help is better than DIY

First things first: What's a WISP and why do you need it?

- Written information security plan (WISP) required for all tax preparers.
- Plan must detail measures to protect sensitive data.
- Ensures compliance with cybersecurity regulations (e.g., FTC Safeguards Rule).
- Penalties for non-compliance up to \$43,000/day.
- Acknowledgment of plan required for PTIN renewal.

Before you decide to write your own WISP, consider these factors:



Understand the time commitment

- Could take up to 40 hours of potentially billable time.
- Requires ongoing maintenance and updates.



Recognize the complexity

Ensure legal compliance
